Aimee Krans reported concern that MWC, with many small fundraisers, would become a club that is "always fundraising."

Polly requested members raise hands/vocalize if they would be willing to volunteer. Several members volunteered. *Polly posted a volunteer request on MWC FB private page.

Consensus made that this is a larger discussion. Will be placed top of agenda for next club business meeting, in March.
